Subject:	Probation Monitoring Program Update
Purpose:	Update on Probation Monitoring for Q4 - FY 2022-2023

Background:

This is a report on the Osteopathic Medical Board of California's (OMBC) Probation Monitoring Program for the fourth guarter of FY 2022-2023. Please refer to attachment 14(a), which encompasses the probation statistics.

Analysis:

In quarter 4, two new probationers were added, ending with a total of thirty-six (36) probationers who were placed on probation for various causes. Of these 36 probationers, eight (8) remained tolling out of state and not receiving credit towards the completion of probation.

Of the 36 licensees on probation, four were participating in the Board's Diversion Program. One issue of non-compliance involving a participant was reported for the quarter. The diversion program remediated the issue of non-compliance by requiring the participant to submit an essay detailing the actions and steps they will take to avoid the issue in the future.
