Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Uniform Standards for Substance Abusing Licensees and Disciplinary Guidelines as required by SB 1441

Sections Affected: California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 1661.2 and 1663

Updated Purpose: The Osteopathic Medical Board of California is proposing to add clarifying language indicating that, notwithstanding the Disciplinary Guidelines, any Proposed Decision that includes a finding that a licensee engaged in any act of sexual contact with a patient or committed or was convicted of a sex offense, will include an order revoking the license in accordance with sections 726, 729 and 2246 and of the Business and Professions Code.
