REQUESTED ACTION:

This report is intended to provide the Members of the Osteopathic Medical Board of California (OMBC) with an update on the probation program. No action is needed.

Total Numbers of physicians on probation

- As of today's date, there are 36 licensees on probation.
- 5 are tolling out of state and are not receiving credit towards completion of probation.
- 31 probationary cases are being monitored and are practicing medicine in California.

Public Reprimands being monitored by the probation program

- 2 physicians have received public letters of reprimand and are being monitored for course activity completion and or fines.

Review of cases

Quarterly reviews are conducted both in person, via zoom or telephone with each physician to discuss their specific terms and conditions. All information and all documents are being analyzed, recorded and documented in a full report. The Osteopathic Medical Board's Probation unit has maintained an effective and thorough accountability of our physicians on probation.

Probation Issues

- 1 physician who had a cease practice order has surrendered his license.
- One cease practice order remains in effect on 1 licensee. Upon successful completion of the course/program the cease practice order will be lifted. Failure to successfully complete the course/program, the cease practice order will remain in effect.
